Section 1921 et seq.) and that as allowed in Public Contract Code Section 22300, this contract does not provide for substitution of securities for any monies withheld by the Owner to ensure performance under this contract. Bidders are further notified that this contract does not permit retainage to be placed in escrow nor to be invested for the benefit of the contractor.

The project will also be financed in part with a grant from the North American Development Bank (NADB), through its board Environmental Infrastructure Fund (BEIF), which is funded by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).


